Still waiting for spring and some weather changes and it looks like they might be on the way. The time changed yesterday so maybe that is a good thing too!

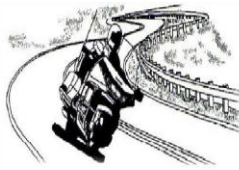
